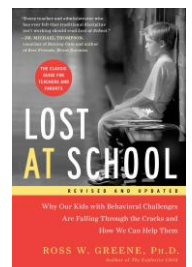
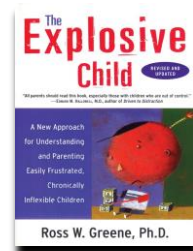

Dr. Greene lectures and consults widely throughout the world and lives in Portland, Maine.
